

## **Certificate IV in Ageing Support (CHC43015 – AQF)**

### **Program Overview**

The Certificate IV in Ageing Support (CHC43015) is an Australian Vocational Qualification delivered in Sri Lanka through REC Campus in partnership with Alana Kaye College, Australia (RTO). The program is designed to prepare students for employment in the aged care sector through a combination of online learning, practical training, workplace exposure, and competency-based assessment.

### **Key Highlights**

- Practical and skills-based learning approach.
- No traditional written examinations.

### **Entry Requirements**

- Minimum age requirement: 16 years and above.
- Recommended minimum qualification: G.C.E. O/L.
- Ability to communicate in English.
- Passion for supporting and caring for older people.

### **Course Structure**

- Course Duration: Minimum 06 Months
- Online lectures delivered by Australian trainers through the LMS learning platform.
- Students are required to complete 120 hours of practical placement.
- Practical training conducted at REC Campus Skills & Simulation Lab on Sundays (Two weeks per month).
- Workplace-based learning opportunities integrated throughout the program. Students gain hands-on experience in personal care assistance, dementia support, person-centered care, effective communication and client support, promoting independence and wellbeing, and professional workplace practices within aged care environments.

**Assessments** are competency-based and conducted through assignments, practical simulations, workplace activities, portfolio evidence, and trainer observations to evaluate both theoretical knowledge and practical skills. Students are assessed against industry standards and awarded outcomes as either Competent (C) or Not Yet Competent (NYC).
